

National Security helps ease the financial burden of massive medical bills with affordable rates.

When a critical illness strikes, expenses pile up and income seems to shrink. National Security's critical illness insurance is designed to help ease the financial burden of mounting medical bills and other expenses not covered by your major medical insurance. With lump sum payment, this insurance is also designed to give you back control of how your expenses are handled.

This policy pays lump sum benefits of \$5,000 to \$50,000 per covered insured available in increments (units) of \$5,000 for the initial diagnosis of a specified critical illness. There is no survival requirement to receive benefits. Benefits reduce 50% at age 65. For individual policies, this policy terminates when 100% of the face amount has been paid. For family policies, coverage for a covered person terminates when 100% of the face amount for that covered person has been paid. However, the policy continues to be in force for the remaining covered persons. Benefits are subject to a 30 day waiting period.

*Each of these conditions are payable only once per insured. If one or more of these benefits are paid, the remaining amount payable will consist of the original face amount reduced by all prior benefit payments.

Skin Cancer Benefit

A skin cancer benefit is also included with Option A that pays \$100 per year for removal of non-life-threatening skin cancer up to a maximum of \$500 per covered person. This benefit is the same regardless of the number of units purchased.

Critical Illness Wellness Benefit

The addition of a Wellness Rider pays for the following tests for the presence of a critical illness up to \$50 per year; mammography, pap smear, flexible sigmoidoscopy, hemocult stool specimen, chest x-ray, colonoscopy, Ther 2-10, CA 125, CEA, EKG, blood tests to confirm elevated cardiac enzymes, thallium scan, MUGA scan, and stress echocardiograms. A premium of \$2.75 for Individuals and 1-parent families and \$4.15 for 2-parent families is added to the total monthly rate.
